Heartworm Disease Can Cause:

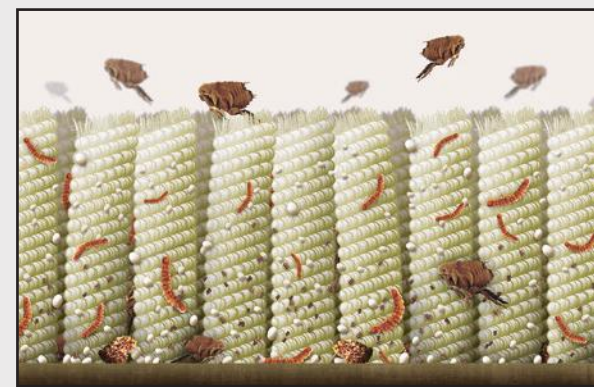
- Permanent damage to blood vessels and lungs
- Heart failure
- Fluid in lungs and abdomen
- Death

Treating Heartworm Disease Can:

- Be traumatic and painful
- Require hospitalization
- Treatment period lasts as long as 3-4 months
- Cost \$1,000 or more¹

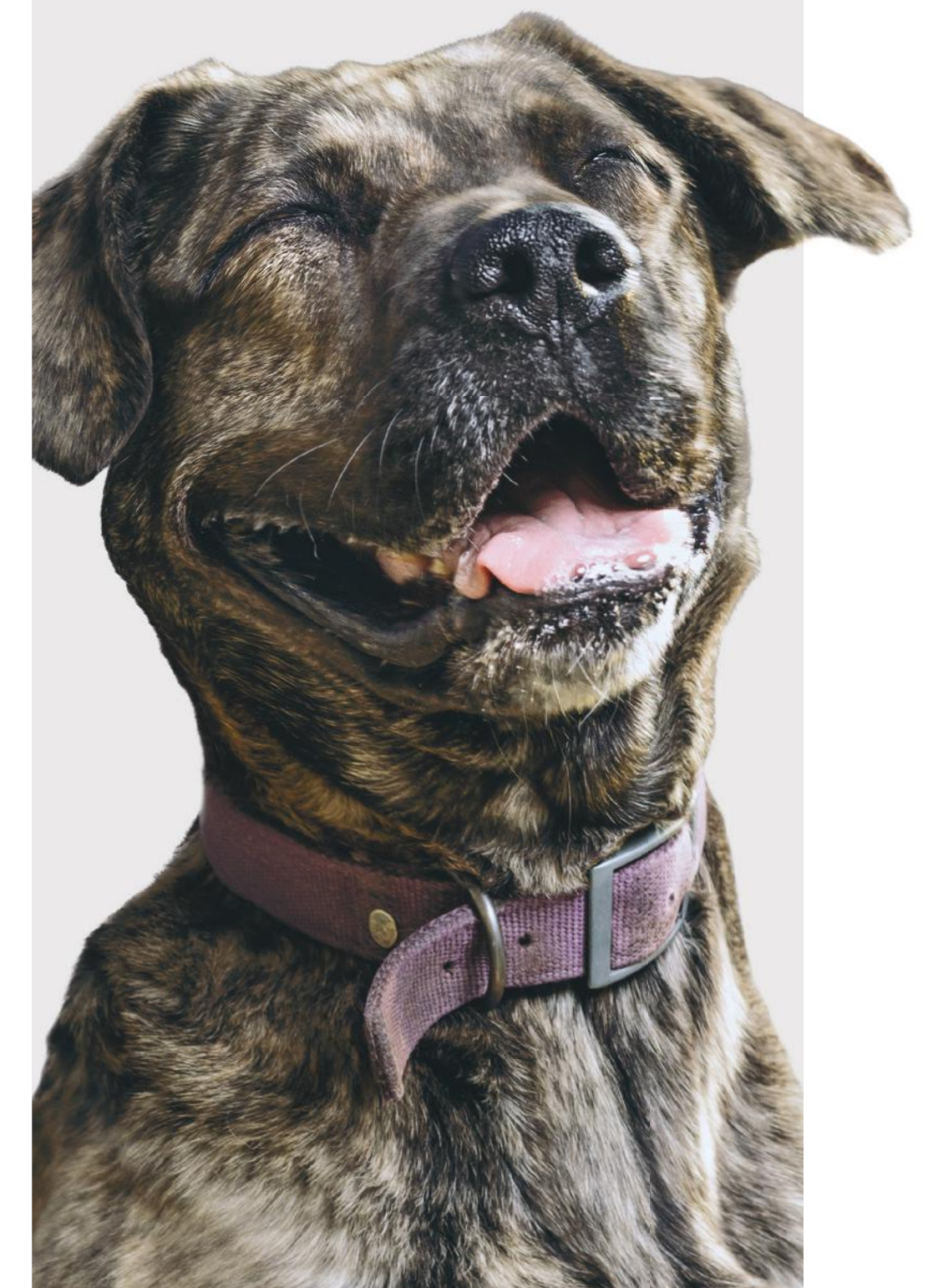
